CAA PARTICIPANTS

Company representatives:

- All participating companies are asked to nominate two representatives (one primary and one alternate representative). Only one representative is expected to join the live sessions.
- Ideally, the representative will be responsible for GHG emissions accounting, management and/or reporting.
- Participants are required to complete online on-demand sessions and attend the live sessions.
- Certificates are available upon completion of the programme.

Time commitment:

- In total, participants should plan to dedicate **25 to 30 hours** to the Climate Ambition Accelerator over six months.
- On average, participants may expect around nine hours of self-learning on-demand content and 12 hours of facilitated group sessions.


