## **OUR TOP TIPS TO HELSINKI**

1 GETTING HERE

If you're travelling by plane, we recommend taking a train from the airport to the city center. A one-way ticket costs 4,40 € and the trip takes around 30 minutes.

2 USE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION OR WALK

Helsinki is a very walkable city, so make sure to bring comfy footwear. If you're using public transportation, download the <u>HSL app</u>, where you can plan your journey and buy tickets. You can also purchase tickets with contactless payment.

BE PREPARED FOR ANY WEATHER

Weather-wise, Helsinki is no different from the rest of the Nordics – be prepared for anything, and don't forget your umbrella!

4 LEARN THE LANGUAGE

Finns are usually fluent in English, but learning a couple of Finnish phrases may prove to be useful.

- Moi / Hei  $\rightarrow$  Hi / hello (when greeting)
- Moi moi → Bye bye (when leaving)
- Kyllä kiitos / Ei kiitos → Yes please / No thank you
- Hauska tavata → Nice to meet you
- Kaunis ilma tänään → Nice weather today
- Mennään saunaan → Let's go to the sauna
